

Summer excursions and workshop programme 2012

Shadows & reflections, Colours & Shapes, Cityscapes, Events, Out of Town
10 sessions commencing 9 May, June, July 2012 7- 9pm & weekends by agreement

Session 1 WORKSHOP Techniques session. Using Shadows & reflections, to create striking images... Exposure, under & over exposure, building your style, focus, depth of field and creative effects. Review of Picasa and Piknik image editing

Session 2 Visit to Bristol and a walk to Castle Park and along the waterway upstream from Bristol Bridge.

Session 3 WORKSHOP Techniques session. Using colours & shapes to best advantage. Lighting and light sources, managing colour, identifying creative shapes, using found shapes... sails, masts, buildings etc. Building your style, focus, depth of field and creative effects..

Session 4 Visit to Oldbury Yacht Club and the Severn estuary at Littleton including sunset.

Session 5 WORKSHOP Cityscapes. Techniques session. Lighting and light sources, sky, urban lights and changing lights at dusk. Managing scale, identifying creative vistas and views, managing movement, lights and vehicles. Building your style, focus, depth of field and creative effects.

Session 6 Bristol urban landscape. Visit to Christmas Steps and Corn St to explore urban buildings, historic city centre and urban grit.

Session 7 WORKSHOP Picture shows; preparing your best images for printing and showing on an image website.

Session 8 Visit to Castle Combe to explore the village landscape. Focus on the English village, catching the atmosphere of the country. Traditional buildings and village gardens and the hostelry!!

Session 9 WORKSHOP Summer events Techniques session. Developing the photographers view. Visual reconnaissance, lighting and light sources, people, movement and colours, identifying creative composition, capturing detail. Building your style, focus, depth of field and creative effects.

Session 10 It was sad that St Pauls carnival was cancelled this year, but we can visit Portishead Flower Show or the Harbourside Festival, both great visual events in their own right. The class will decide!! Joining in, picking viewpoints, identifying the best action and the best colour and capturing great photo opportunities.
